

## Some Suggestions On Points Of Interest And Activities

# In Belgium: Sports and nature

- Hiking along the GR 16 'Sentier de la Semois' and the Gaumepath 'Transgaumaise'.
- Visit of Cugnon, Mortehan, Auby, Dohan, Laiche, Azy, Martué, Chiny and Moyen, the villages of the Semois.
- \* 'La Roche à l'Appel' in Muno, an interesting geological rockformation.
- 'Le Tombeau du chevalier' in Herbeumont and 'le Tombeau du géant' in Frahan, with splendid panoramic views of the Semois river.
- 'Lac des Epioux', a quiet lake in the middle of the forest.
- Renting boats and canoes to discover the river Semois starting at Chiny, Lacuisine or Chassepierre in the direction of Herbeumont and Bouillon.
- Horseriding in Le Breux (Chassepierre), Lacuisine and Pure (Fr)
- Cross-country skiing at la Bergerie in Florenville and elsewhere in wintertime.
- Fishing in the rivers Semois and Vire.

#### Leisure and culture

- The city of Florenville, a cosy little town with shops, restaurants, supermarkets (open on Sundays) and a tourist information office.
- Carnaval at Florenville in the month of March
- International festival on streetarts in Chassepierre (August).
- Jazz festival in Rossignol (Tintigny), also in August.
- Visit of Torgny, the southernmost village of the Belgian Gaume.
- Bio markets in Chassepierre, Florenville, Orgeo, Han and Avioth.
- Starting in May, there are many brocantes and 'vide greniers' in Fontenoille and other places around, for instance in Arlon.

- Sallo-Roman site and cosy troutrestaurant in Chameleux.
- The abbey of Orval, famous for its beer and medieval ruines.
- The abbey of Notre-Dame de Clairefontaine in Bouillon.
- Castles of Herbeumont and Bouillon.
- Museum of the Gaume region in Virton.

#### **In nearby France:**

- The typical village of Williers, near Chameleux.
- Old gothic "basilique des champs" in Avioth. Also bio market.
- Impressive fortifications in Montmédy.
- The renaissance-architecture of Marville and the ossuary of the St.-Hilaire graveyard with 40 000 skuls.
- The biggest medieval castle of Europe in Sedan.
- Many commemorative sites on the Maginot line that bear witness to the First and Second World Wars such as war cemeteries, citadels, fortresses, ramparts, bunkers... in Montmédy, Sedan, Charleville-Mesnières, Bastogne...
- Mouzon, a village along the river Meuse with a museum on the fabrication of felt, a Gothic church and gardens in French style.
- Biking along the river Meuse.
- ✤ A little further the famous cathedral of Reims.

### For the children

- The castle of Bouillon with hunting birds demonstrations, an animal park, a touristic train, the adventure park, karting and paddling on the river Semois.
- Mining site 'Au coeur de l'Ardoise' in Bertrix with underground visit.
- In the village of Les Hayons, at the "Ferme des Fées" you will learn about the witches, fairy queens and elfs of the Ardennes in the 19th century.
- In Florenville, the playground du Miroir, a mini golf, swimming pool, and X-Cape Aventure.
